JOHN NEWKIRK LOCEY, the third child of Daniel and Hester Taylor Locey, was born about the year 1801, near Bloomingburg, Sullivan County New York,

A century of time has dimmed the tragic story of "Uncle Jud". A niece who doubtless knew him in Grant County, Wisconsin, told the brief story nearly fifty years after his death:

John Newkirk Locey was married and lived in Ohio. There was a tragedy. His wife was unfaithful. There were no children so he left her and came to Illinois and Wisconsin. He died in Wisconsin about 1863, aged 64. He never owned up to his relatives that he had been married. His whole life was changed and blighted.

"All was ended now, the hope, and the fear, and the sorrow".
