FRANCES JANE LOCEY HOLLINGSHEAD MORRISON

1808 - 1881

b-VI FRANCES JANE LOCEY, the sixth child of Daniel and Hester Taylor Locey, was born January 12, 1808 near Bloomingburg, Sullivan County, New York, died on August 13, 1881, at Williamsport, Pennsylvania, and is buried at Williamsport. She was twice married.

She was married (1) to DR. DANIEL HOLLINGSHEAD in 1837 in Clinton County, Illinois. Tradition has the following story, "He had a very sick patient. There was no bridge and the river was high. He tried to swim it, lost his saddle bags, and slipped off his horse to grab them. He went down and never rose". It is not sure that he died in Illinois or Wisconsin, probably Grant County.

They had two children: Sarah Ann and Martha Abigail.

William Morrison and his older sons drove an ox-team to California in 1849. He made money, returned to Wisconsin by way of Cape Horn, and built a fine home near Lancaster. He died of an injury while working on his farm, possibly on April 21, 1856 (Record not clear). The children of William and Frances Jane Hollingshead Morrison: Marshal De Tandebar, Daniel Locey, Harriet Catherine, Alvin Madison, and Daniel Locey.
