BEULAH ANN LOCEY CRIPPEN BONNER  
1819 - 1861

BEULAH ANN LOCEY, the tenth child of Daniel and Hester Locey, was born Dec. 6, 1819, near Bloomingburg, Sullivan County, New York, died June 15, 1861, and is buried in the old Johnson Cemetery, five miles south of Carlyle, Illinois. She was twice married.

ALEXANDER McCRIPPEN, was born August 20, 1815 at Columbia, Tennessee, died July 2, 1850, and is buried in the old Wingville Cemetery near Fennimore, Grant County, Wisconsin. He was an Indian trader, Indian fighter, lead miner, and died as a result of caring for fellow members of the Odd Fellows during a cholera epidemic that swept southwestern Wisconsin. His people were southern planters and slave owners. Some of his brothers, tradition says five, lost their lives in the Confederate armies.

They were married Nov. 14, 1841 near Lancaster. Their children: George W., Cornelia Locey, Frances Jane, and George W.

BEULAH ANN LOCEY CRIPPEN, was married (2) to REV. WILLIAM BONNER in 1852 in Illinois. Their children: William and Daniel.
